- · Poster topic may be in the following scientific fields: ADME, bioanalysis, drug delivery, pharmaceutical analysis, pharmaceutical development, or PK-PD
- Applicant must have ≤5 years of working experience. Please be mindful that graduate study is not counted as working experience in this context. Post-doc study is considered working experience

Award Application Process

- · To apply for this award, poster submissions must include a completed Application Form accompanied by your abstract. These items should be forwarded via email to: Dr. Wenfang Miao (wenfang.miao@pharmaron.com), and Dr. Ziqiang "Zack" Cheng (ziqiang.z.cheng@gsk.com)
- The Application Form must be signed by the applicant and the applicant's academic/scientific advisor or line manager. The signed Application Form should be scanned and then attached with email.

Deadline for submission is March 15, 2011

- Applicant must have ≤5 years of working experience. Please be mindful that graduate study is not counted as working experience in this context. Post-doc study is considered working experience
- Application and abstract will be reviewed by the Award Committee. If the application is accepted, applicant's registration fee will be waived (for students) or reduced by 50% (for post-doctors and research scientists). Poster will be further reviewed at the conference. Awards (1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes) will be given out at the CPSA Closing Ceremony. Winners will be selected based on the quality and potential significance of the research presented in their posters.

Your poster number will be designated on your board in the Yangtze Ballroom. Authors must be in attendance at their posters during the poster sessions (see below) . Posters should remain on the boards for the entire period of the meeting. The poster area is open for viewing during the entire Symposium.

Thursday, April 14: 5:30 pm - 6:30 pm Friday, April 15: 11:00 am - 12:00 pm

Poster boards will be located in the Yangtze Ballroom and will be available for set-up anyime from 9:00 am on Thursday, April 14 to 10:00 am on Friday, April 15. All materials must be removed by 7:00 pm on Friday, April 15, or it will be discarded. When taking down your poster, please also remove the pushpins from your own board. Also, remember to take any business cards that are in your envelope – these people are requesting reprints of your abstract.
