

Call for Nominations for the 2020 CACA Student Excellence Awards Sponsored by Mac-Mod Analytical

The Chinese American Chromatography Association (CACA) invites applications for two **2020** CACA **Student Excellence Award**. The Award recognizes outstanding contributions to the development of separation science and its applications, especially in the field of chromatography. The **2020** CACA **Student Excellence Award** is supported by Mac-Mod Analytical (http://www.mac-mod.com/) and will be announced at the CACA networking dinner event to be held at Pittcon 2020 (March 1-5, 2020, McCormick Place, Chicago, Illinois, USA) with the presentation of a \$500 cash award. The awardee is requested to participate in the networking dinner event at Pittcon 2020 in Chicago.

Eligibility:

The CACA Student Excellent Award is open to all CACA members who are graduate students at the time of the award session. Two awards are planned at this time.

Evaluation:

Application packages will be evaluated by the CACA Awards committee. The applicants are judged on the originality and overall quality of research, significance to the advancement of separation science, and other supporting factors.

Application package:

An application package must consist of the following items,

- 1) A cover letter summarizing the applicant's contribution to the field of separation science.
- 2) A resume including contact information, academic credentials, work experience, and a publication list.
- 3) In the cover letter, please include 2 references (email and phone) from mentors, supervisors, colleagues or other experts, who can testify to the candidate's accomplishments. References will be contacted.
- 4) A headshot photo.

The candidates can be self-nominated or nominated by any separation science experts in the field. The deadline for the **2020 CACA Student Excellence Award** application is **November 1, 2019**.
